Six \$5 000 undergrad scholarships for Quantitative Marine Biology students to support an Honours year, or the final year of an undergraduate degree

To apply you must:

- have at least **one** statistics, mathematics, or computing course in 2nd year, and
- undertake or will have completed, **two** statistics, mathematics, or computing courses, **as well as** marine biology in 3rd year.

Scholarships will contribute towards course fees and be paid directly to the university at the start of semester one and two dependent on acceptable grades having been received.

Fisheries New Zealand hopes to form an ongoing relationship with the scholarship recipients to promote the progression of these students to the postgraduate level.

To be eligible you must attend a University that has an explicit marine biology course in the third year, and be a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident.
